Before making or finalizing arrangements for your trip through Students Fare, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. **Health Risks and Other Hazards:** *You agree that it is your personal decision to travel and that you do so under full knowledge of current travel recommendations and travel restrictions in regard to the risks of COVID-19.* Students Fare assumes no responsibility for and shall not be liable for any unsafe conditions or health hazards including pandemics or other illnesses Students Fare has no special knowledge of dangers during travel or at destinations. For information related to such dangers, it is recommended you visit the State Department travel website at www.travel.state.gov, click on "Find International travel Information" then click on "Country Information", and fill in the name of the destination country. For medical and health information, it is recommended you visit the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) website at www.cdc.gov/travel, then click on "Destinations" and scroll to the name of the destination country.

2. **Vaccination Requirements and Other Rules:** Students Fare has no responsibility for COVID-19-related requirements that travel suppliers and governments may impose from time to time, such as **required vaccinations**, health affidavit forms, COVID-19 screenings prior to departure or upon arrival, face coverings, or quarantines. 3. **Rebooking:** If requested, Students Fare will assist with obtaining any refunds due or rebooking trips for future credits based on airline/supplier rules. Students Fare will charge a non-refundable fee for our services in addition to any applicable airline/supplier fees.

4. **Insurance:** For your protection, it is strongly recommended that you purchase trip cancellation and travel accident insurance. Please note that, unless you buy a cancel-for-any-reason policy, most policies have a specific clause stating they do not cover epidemics and pandemics, especially when travel warnings are in place. You must file any suit within one year of the incident, and you acknowledge that this expressly limits the applicable statute of limitations to one year. You agree that the courts in Oakland County, Michigan (State Court) or in Wayne County, Michigan (Federal Court) will be the exclusive jurisdiction for all claims brought by you, and you hereby submit to the personal jurisdiction of those courts.
